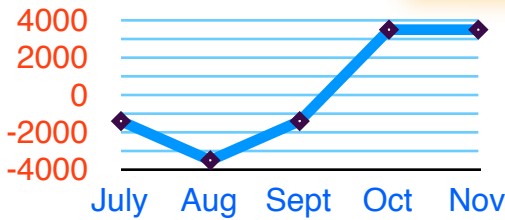


Dear Friends,

JUAREZ, MEXICO

The level of violence has diminished in Juarez this year to about half the number of murders. (From about 4000/year to 2000) We would ask you to continue to pray for God's protection over this people who live in Juarez, and Mexico. Pray that they will be lights in the darkness and that the Holy Spirit will work in them and through them to make Christ known.

Recently, Samuel Lopez - who is starting the Border of Grace Presbyterian church in Juarez, shared about his experience of living in the midst of the violence. He says that it is difficult to describe the atrocities and inhumanity that they have witnessed and some members of the church have experienced in the death of loved ones. Earlier this year Samuel received several threatening telephone calls. However, in the midst of his fear he found comfort and spiritual strength for Psalm 91:7 - *A thousand may fall at your side, ten thousand at your right hand, but it will not come near you.* God took away the discouragement and the fear that paralyze him and has given him a spirit of hope and peace. Pray that this church will grow in the midst of the storm!
