A city of 2.7 million in desperate need of the gospel!

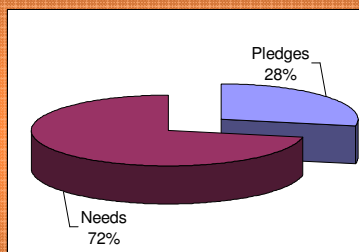
In December, we revisited the border to reconnect with the BEAMM team members we'll be serving with. This time we took our children so they could meet our teammates and see what the border is like. They fell in love with the Mexicans and found friends in Juarez and El Paso. This is an answer to our prayers and we are thankful that our kids are as excited as we are to move to the border.

In Juarez, we spent some time at one of the BEAMM church plants, Promesa de Vida (Promise of Life), which is located in an area that has seen 100 murders this past year. It is a very poor part of town, yet the people are welcoming and open to the gospel. We visited the one-room home of Jorge, Guadalupe, and Christian, a boy they took in. Jorge has a bicycle cart business selling corn-on-a-stick, corn-husks, and corn flour in the neighborhood. Atop his Catholic home, three ears of corn are placed in offering to the spirits to bless his business. In spite of this, Christian studies the Bible at Promesa De Vida, and shares with his illiterate parents.

We felt the darkness and spiritual battle strongly this time in Juarez. Our longing to go there and minister to these dear people grew stronger than ever. The nationals and the BEAMM team members long for us to be there working alongside. Please pray the Lord would speak to the hearts of many to support this ministry and that we would be patient with His timing.
