I have a seven-weeks-in-a-row Seminary teaching assignment yet to fulfill. Please pray for stamina, focus, wisdom, love, and effectiveness. Our support level is low. We have a \$1,300/month shortage. **Please pray for more churches and individuals to make monthly pledges and/or contribute with a one-time gift toward our Mission to North America account.**

Leticia has been working hard for the Seminary students, especially for the ladies (and students' wives). Last month we had a Mission Team (seven people) from Parkview Church PCA in Atlanta, Georgia. They helped us with some construction and improvement to the church building (Renovation Presbyterian in Ciudad Juarez) where we hold our Seminary classes. They offered a three-day series of conferences on the theme: "Integrity vs. Sin", which resulted in a special blessing to the 70-80 adults plus children who attended. Two ladies of the Mission Team were nurses. They did a health drive, and **discovered that my blood pressure is high and my glucose level needs to be lowered.** They also tested most of the students and many church members from different congregations. **Please praise the Lord for the countless blessings we received through the Parkview Church Team.** Leticia was not feeling well, but after taking some antibiotics, she is much better. **Pray for her health and praise the Lord for her life.**

Aaron Jr (single, 29) was able to visit with us last weekend. He is working in Phoenix, Arizona. It was a joy to spend some time with him. He is a Christian. **Please pray for a closer walk with the Lord.**
