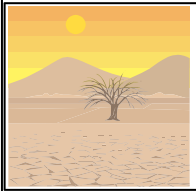

SEMINARIO SAN PABLO

The San Pablo Seminary is doing very well. We have fifteen students in the School of Theology (two **just graduated** in the fourth year, there are four in the third year, four in the second year, and five in the first year).



Our four available classrooms are very limited in space. We have

already pre-enrolled eight new students who are planning to start the four-year program in August. We are praying for at least two more students to

enroll. As you know, we have been praying for ten new students.

GRADUATION

Our Graduation Ceremonies were on Saturday, June 7. Two students, as reported already, obtained their Licensure in Theology Degree, and forty one students received their Diplomas in Music (Guitar



and Keyboard). We had a week-long Music Camp (2-7 June) just before the Graduation Worship Service.



SAN PABLO SEMINARY LADIES

Leticia's work with the San Pablo Seminary Ladies is going very well. Ten ladies meet regularly. Leticia has been leading them into eight areas: **Bible study, Book ministry, Counseling, Clothing, Food and Fellowship, Service and raising support for Scholarships for ladies** who would like to enroll at Seminary. This group is an inspiration to the whole Seminary community.

Our son Aaron (Jr.) works in Phoenix, AZ and bought a townhouse there. Our son Marcos is back home, working hard to finish college at the University of Texas at El Paso (UTEP).
